- Name calling, personal attacks, or disrespectful or defamatory comments about a person or organization
- Spam comments or posts intending to sell a product or services
- Comments that violate a person's personal privacy or the sharing of personal and confidential information about another person and/or organization
- Other comments that the social media team deems inappropriate
